What is the goal of the Tennessee Rural Sexual Assault Expansion Project?

The goal of the project is to enhance the safety of child, youth, and adult sexual assault victims living in sixteen rural counties in Tennessee by making services more available and accessible.

What are the activities of this project?

The Coalition will:

- Increase the capacity of six programs to provide a full range of sexual assault services to adult and minor victims in 16 rural Tennessee counties.
- Create a coordinated community response to sexual assault in rural Tennessee counties.
- Provide a statewide Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) training to increase the number of SANEs in rural communities.
- Provide trainings on sexual assault.
